

Hello! Today I am going to teach you how to make a simple, beginner friendly keychain!

Abbreviations:

Slip knot

Chain stitch

Double crochet (CAN terms)

Slip stitch

Yarn:

For this project, I used the Sugar'n Cream

cotton yarn in black.

You can really use any yarn for this project.

What you will need:

Scissors

4.0 Crochet Hook

Yarn

Darning needle

Pattern:

To begin, you will need to make a slip knot and chain 30.





Once you chain 30, make 3 DC in the 6th chain from the hook.



Ch 1, then do 3 DC in the same stitch. This is a shell stitch .



Skip 6 st and do 3 DC in the 6th stitch.



Chain one and do 3 DC in the same stitch.

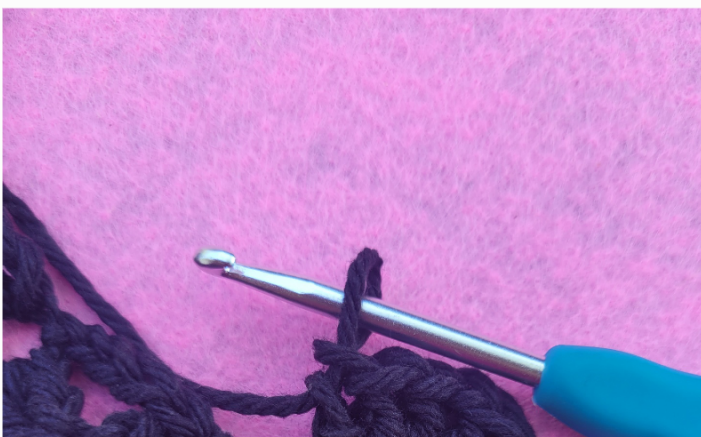


Repeat the shell stitch until the end of the 30 chains.



Once you do the last shell stitch in the 30th chain, flip your project upside down.

Without a chain stitch, in the same hole you were just working in, make 1 shell stitch.





Make shell stitches in the same holes as the stitches on the bottom all the way till the end of the row.



Make a slip stitch into the very first stitch you made, fasten off.



Now your done!
